

JOINING FEES

The first 2 sessions your child participates in are considered a trial and costs £15 to cover both sessions .

These 2 sessions are payable in advance before your child's first session, preferably by bank transfer (see details below).

Proof of payment must be shown on arrival.

If your child would like to continue at CGC after their 2 week trial, we then send you an email before you're 3rd week asking you to pay the remainder of the months fees and to sign up to become a member of British Gymnastics.



BRITISH GYMNASTICS FEES

As a British Gymnastics affiliated centre, all of our participants require British Gymnastics Membership after their 2nd week to be able to participate. This provides all gymnasts with:

CGC FEES

Monthly fees for 1 hour sessions are £28.75 per month. Fees must be paid monthly in advance, before the **1st of the month** by Standing Order. Payments not received by the 1st of the month will incur an admin fee of £5 and your child will be unable to participate until payment is up to date. Club fees are non-refundable.

UNIFORM

All members are always expected to wear the appropriate uniform. New members can wear shorts and fitted t-shirt for first few weeks.

*A CGC t-shirt

*A CGC leotard in yellow, orange or fade up

*A pair of fitted leggings or shorts in black, grey, white or CGC colours (yellow, orange, red)

NB. A CGC t-shirt for new members is acceptable. Club leotards can be ordered on our online shop via our website. No baggy joggers, jeans, crop tops, jumpers with buttons or zips due to health and safety reasons.

VIEWING + LATENESS

Unfortunately we're unable to allow anyone into the gym after their class start time. There is a 10 minute window prior to your child's class start time to ensure they are on time.

This is for health and safety of your child and for all participants in our care. We do however allow 1 catch up session a month for anyone who misses to to illness or lateness.

Please wait with your child in the waiting area until a coach collects them for their session. You are welcome to wait here and watch the session on the TV.



HOLIDAY & CANCELLATIONS

We charge for 46 weeks of the year, divided into 12 equal monthly payments. We close for 2 weeks over Christmas, 2 weeks at Easter and 2 weeks in the Summer.

We are open as normal on bank holidays.

We hope you are happy at CGC, but should you wish to leave we require 1 months' paid notice, to be paid in advance to the month. Your child is welcome to attend their notice period.

PARKING

Please ensure you park in the designated spaces provided outside the gym. If the car park is full, please park on the road further up the industrial estate. Members are not allowed to park between the gates or along the barrier by preci spark. Please see the Health and Safety policy for more information.
